GENERAL ELECTION – NOVEMBER 2, 2010**

Voting with the ES&S iVotronic Voting Machine

1. Activate Ballot

A poll worker will activate your electronic ballot.

After reviewing the Instruction screen, press “View Ballot” to begin voting.

2. Select Straight Party (Optional)

To select the straight party option, touch anywhere in the white box surrounding the party designation of your choice. This will give a vote to all of the candidates running under that party. You may also split your ballot by selecting the straight party option and then voting for individual candidates of any other party or body.

3. Select Candidates

To select your candidates, touch anywhere in the white box surrounding the candidate’s name. To de-select, touch the box again. The iVotronic will not allow you to over-vote an office.

4. Review Ballot

After completing the last ballot page, touch “Review” and carefully read the review screens. To change or make a new choice, touch anywhere in the white box surrounding the candidate’s name; the office contest will reappear. De-select the candidate and select a new one of your choice. Touch “Review” to return to the review screens.

5. Casting Ballot

After reviewing the last review page, the “VOTE” button will begin to flash red. When you are satisfied with your selections press the red “VOTE” button; a confirmation screen will appear. To make a change, touch “Return to Ballot.” To cast your ballot touch “Confirm” on the screen OR the red “VOTE” button.

“Your ballot has been cast. Thank you for voting” means you have properly cast your ballot and you may now leave the voting machine.
